ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN FAYETTEVILLE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND HOME BUILDERS INSTITUTE

This articulation agreement is made and entered into by and between Fayetteville Technical Community College, a North Carolina Community College System Institution (hereinafter "FTCC") and the Home Builders Institute (hereinafter "HBI"). FTCC and HBI hereby join in a collaborative effort to facilitate the transfer of students graduating from the HBI into the Associate of Applied Science in Building Construction Technology and the Associate of Applied Science in Electrical Systems Technology at FTCC and agree to the following activities:

FTCC agrees to:

- Award credit for prior learning upon successful completion of the HBI program (see Exhibit Acrosswalk)
- Encourage HBI participants to complete the HBI program prior to enrolling at FTCC
- Provide HBI with program and marketing materials
- Visit HBI classes and graduations to recruit and share opportunities with students
- Maintain accreditation with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC)

HBI agrees to:

- Distribute FTCC program and marketing materials to HBI students
- Invite FTCC personnel to visit HBI classes and graduations to recruit and share opportunities with students in HBI operated programs
- Provide documentation to FTCC of successful program completion by HBI students who have applied to an FTCC program or otherwise granted HBI permission to do so
- Provide FTCC access to training materials for the purpose of review for alignment to FTCC course objectives
- Notify FTCC officials of any changes to the scope and quality of the HBI program

This articulation agreement shall be effective from the date of signatures and shall be reviewed at least once every three years. FTCC and HBI reserve the right to terminate this agreement at any time, provided notice of intent to terminate is provided in writing at least ninety (90) days prior to the effective date of termination. If this agreement is determined to violate board policies, North Carolina Community College System policies and procedures, or laws and regulations of the United States, the State of North Carolina or any of its political subdivisions, this agreement shall be terminated immediately.
