Dear President,

This letter serves as a termination notice for the Two-Plus Articulation Agreement between North Carolina Community Colleges and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro for students earning an Associates of Applied Science at a NCCC in order to pursue a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Health, with a concentration in Health Studies (online) at UNCG. The Bachelor of Science degree in Public Health with a concentration in Community Health Education is still available.

Please know that UNCG continues to be supportive of our relationships with North Carolina's Community Colleges. UNCG will honor the current agreement, so that students who have matriculated to UNCG for Spring 2015 will be continued through completion of the baccalaureate degree.

Also, in compliance with the current agreement, we ask that NCCC's notify current students in the majors indicated above about this termination. Those students have 30 days after notifications by the NCCC of the termination to declare their interest in writing to UNCG if they wish to continue toward a baccalaureate at UNCG under the articulation agreement. 

To Whom It May Concern:

With this Articulation Notice, the University of North Carolina at Greensboro (UNCG) offers the continuation of 2Plus programs with participating schools in the North Carolina Community College System to serve educational needs in the State of North Carolina and its citizenry.

The Articulation Notice pertains to those North Carolina community college students earning one of the following Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degrees who seek to complete the appropriate Bachelor of Science degree at UNCG. Eligible students transferring to UNCG through the 2Plus program gain advanced transfer standing based on AAS degree and approved departmental course credits towards the major.

As an associate degree granting institution, the University recognizes that the institution's faculty are in league with that status. Specifically, career and technical faculty, while aligned with the requisite Southern Association of Colleges and Schools – Commission on Colleges guidelines, may or may not hold a master's degree in the subject area.

This Articulation Notice seeks confirmation from participating parties that programs meet SACS accreditation guidelines. Departmental authorities are asked to review the programs listed below and initial those that are appropriate to continue.

This Articulation Notice should be signed by the College's President and returned to the University Registrar's Office as soon as possible.

Programs that are not marked will be understood as unapproved and students will not be eligible for corresponding 2Plus program advanced transfer standing. We will honor the agreement for current UNCG students, but may not be able to extend that to students who are still at the North Carolina Community College.

If you do not wish to participate in the current 2Plus program with UNCG, please complete the section on the third page.

We look forward to hearing from you and appreciate your continued efforts to support our 2Plus Program.
