<u>State Budget Revision Report as of February 28, 2014</u> Allocation carried forward from the last report was \$64,736,947.00. Total net increase to the budget is \$365,969.00 for a total allocation of \$65,102,916.00 as of February 28, 2014.

<u>Curriculum Committee</u> The Curriculum Committee met at 10:45 a.m. prior to this meeting. Dr. Marye J. Jeffries, Chairwoman, presented the report to the Board.

<u>All American Veterans' Center Briefing</u> The new All American Veterans' Center will be located on the second floor of the General Classroom Building. - Job placement assistance (veteran specific).
- Networking devices in place/Jobs listing-full disclosure of services available.
- Small business center assistance for those wanting to start a business.
- Free classes (EMT, CNA, Phlebotomy, EKG Tech) using funds provided by the NC Back to Work Grant. (Last classes for this grant end in June.)

(8) Dr. Keen met with the President's Leadership Institute on March 7.
