

Admission Guidelines and Enrollment Process

Admission to the College requires a high school diploma from an accredited institution. A state equivalency certificate or GED test results which meet NC equivalency standards are acceptable in lieu of a high school diploma.

To be eligible to register a student must complete the following:

1. Complete an FTCC Admissions Application.
2. See a Counselor to enter the program and complete an Educational Plan.
3. The ACCUPLACER entry assessment test is required if the student plans to take ENG 111 instead of ENG 101 or higher courses above the 100 levels.
4. If a student is entering from another program and desires to transfer credits, an official transcript is required and will be evaluated in partnership with FTCC Admissions and the Cosmetology Department.

NOTE: Financial Aid is available to students in the form of **grants, scholarships, and work study**. If the student is considering financial aid, they should apply immediately. It takes 6-8 weeks for FA processing.

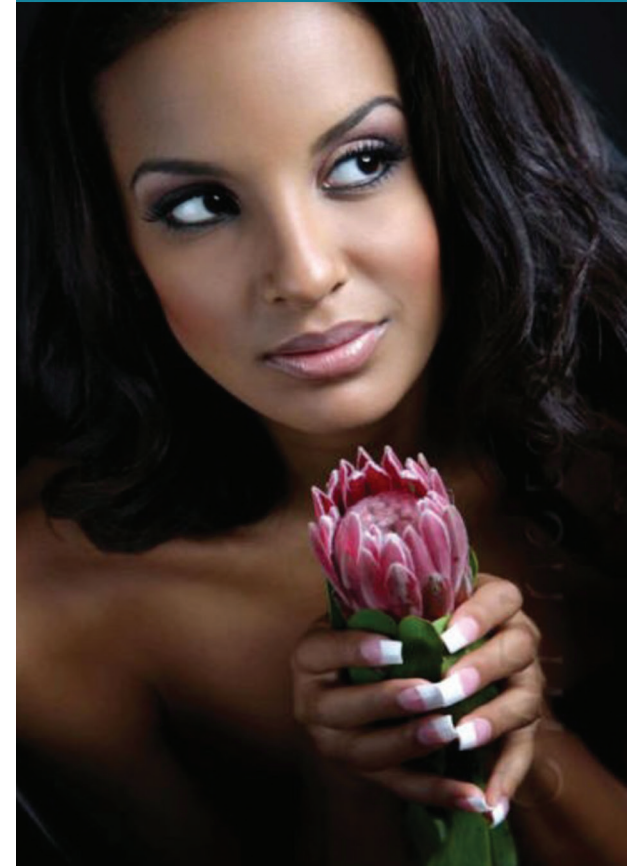

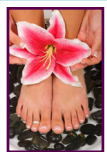

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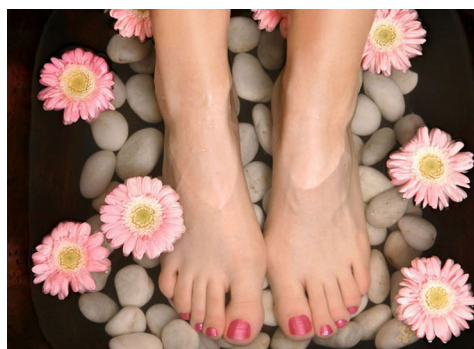

The Manicuring/Nail Technology curriculum provides competency-based knowledge, scientific/artistic principles, and hands-on fundamentals associated with the nail technology industry. The curriculum provides and simulates a salon environment which enables students to develop manipulative skills.



Course work includes instruction in all phases of professional nail technology, business/computer principles, product knowledge, and other related topics.



Graduates should be prepared to take the North Carolina Cosmetology State Board Licensing Exam and upon passing be licensed and qualify for employment in beauty and nail salons, as a platform artist, and in related businesses.
