Admission Guidelines and Enrollment Process

Admission to the College requires a high school diploma from an accredited institution. A state equivalency certificate or GED test results which meet NC equivalency standards are acceptable in lieu of a high school diploma.

To be eligible to register a student must complete the following:

- 1. Complete an FTCC Admissions Application.
- 2. <u>See a Counselor</u> to enter the program and complete an Educational Plan.
- 3. The ACCUPLACER entry assessment test is required if the student plans to take ENG 111 instead of ENG 101 or higher courses above the 100 levels.
- 4. If a student is entering from another program and <u>desires to transfer credits</u>, an official transcript is required and will be evaluated in partnership with FTCC Admissions and the Cosmetology Department.

NOTE: Financial Aid is available to students in the form of **grants**, **scholarships**, **and work study**. If the student is considering financial aid, <u>they should</u> <u>apply immediately</u>. It takes 6-8 weeks for FA processing.


