### **DoD CySP SCHOLARSHIP**

Because FTCC is a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense (NCAE-CD), and we participate in the DoD CySP, you are eligible to apply for the DoD CySP Scholarship that comes with a job offer to work for a DoD agency (if you meet the qualifications).

This scholarship provides *full* tuition and a stipend to cover room and board. The stipend levels are \$22,000 for community college and \$27,000 for 4-year schools.

You must be 18yrs old, be a US Citizen and able to get a security clearance, enrolled at FTCC, have at least one year of school left, and a GPA of 3.75 or higher.
