Welcome to Fayetteville Technical Community College! We are delighted that you will be enrolling at our institution. Congratulations! You have been offered aid for the upcoming school year. This is your offer notification for the above academic year. You are not required to return this document.

After reviewing your offer letter, log into your FTCC Self-Service account for additional information about your financial aid record. If you are offered loans, you must accept or decline the loan offer in your Self-Service account. If you accept the loan offer, you must complete the Master Promissory Note/Loan Agreement and the Entrance Counseling at <https://studentloans.gov> to activate the loan disbursements. Loan disbursements will be in three payments for the fall and spring terms and two payments for summer.

Your total offer is subject to the availability of funds from the appropriate agencies and the laws and regulations which govern these programs, and is thus subject to change. In most cases, a student will receive:

- * 100% of their offer if they are considered to be full time (12+ credits)
- * 75% if they are three quarter-time (9-11 credits)
- * 50% if they are half-time (6-8 credits)
- * 25% if they are less than half-time (1-5 credits)

* Students who receive the North Carolina Community College Grant (NCCCG) will only receive 100% of the offer amount if they are in 15 or more credit hours since this program runs on a full-time plus scale. We encourage students who receive this grant to contact their financial aid advisor to inquire about the exact amount that they will receive based on their EFC (expected family contribution) and their enrollment status.

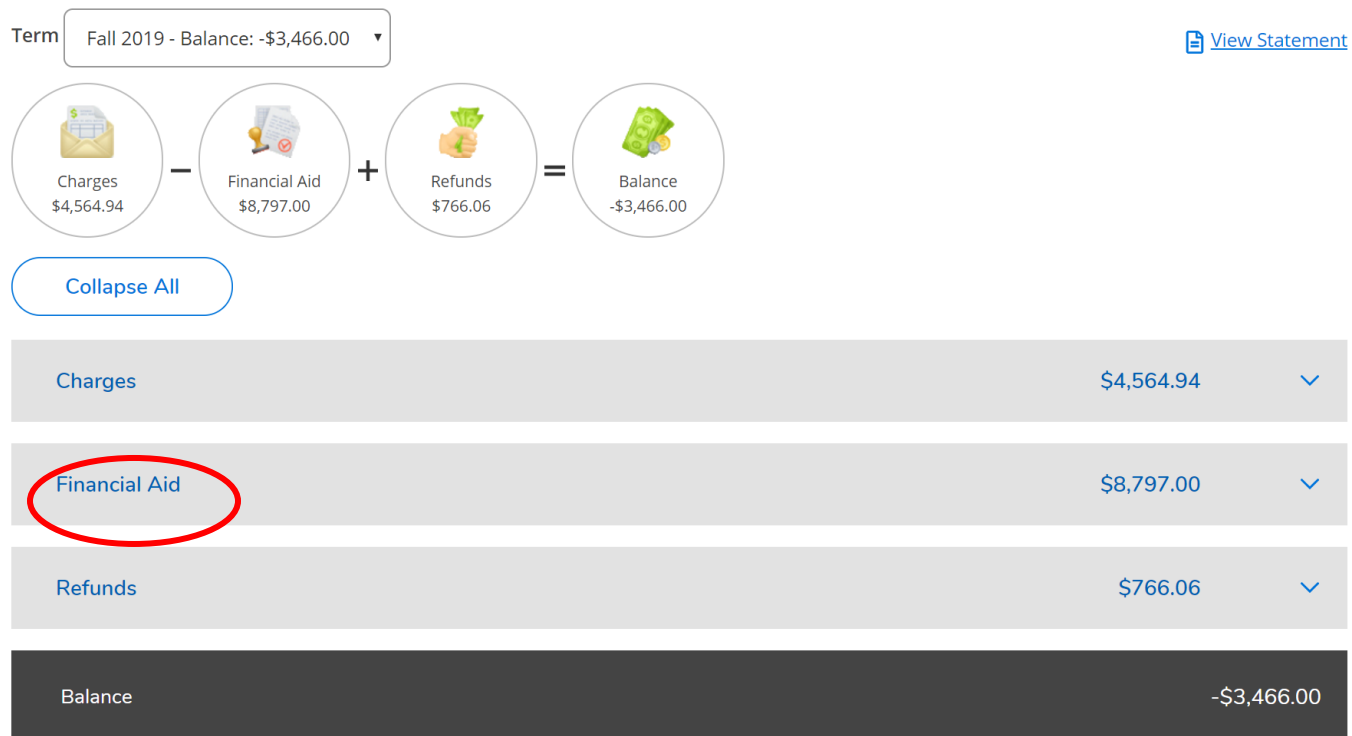

7. Students may be ineligible for funds for the following reasons:

- a. The class has not started. The anticipated amount of financial aid will display 10 days before the section start date of classes for which students are registered.
- b. The Master Promissory Note (MPN) and/or Entrance Counseling are not complete.
 - i. The anticipated amount of loans that are accepted will display after the [Master Promissory Note](#) (MPN) has been submitted. The MPN is a legal document in which students promise to repay loans and any accrued interest and fees to the lender or loan holder.
 - ii. The anticipated amount of loans that are accepted will display after the [Entrance Counseling](#) has been completed. Entrance Counseling is required by the Federal Government to ensure that students understand the responsibilities and obligations of the loan(s) they are assuming.
- c. Not registered for enough credits. Students who are offered financial aid must be registered for classes to be eligible to use the funds. Please see the chart below to see the number of credits in which a student must be enrolled to determine the amount of anticipated aid:

Satisfactory. You are making satisfactory academic progress (SAP). SAP means you are completing at least 67% of the credit hours you attempt plus maintaining at least a 2.0 Financial Aid GPA.

SAP Regained-- Congratulations! You are making satisfactory academic progress. You are meeting the minimum 2.0 financial aid GPA requirement, completion rate (pace) of 67%, and have not exceeded the maximum credit hour limit allowed to complete your program of study.

Appeal Denied--Your appeal was not approved.

Suspended – GPA-- You have not regained SAP and are no longer eligible for aid. This includes any federal or state grants and all federal student loans. Student must have a minimum 2.0 Financial Aid GPA.

Suspended – Pass Rate-- You have not regained SAP and are no longer eligible for aid. This includes any federal or state grants and all federal student loans.
