Competitive Admission Process

There are limited seats for each health program.

All health programs, except Central Sterile Processing, Mammography, Nurse Aide and Surgical First Assistant have a competitive admission process.

Before selection into a program, you must complete all prerequisites and gain competitive points.

You may take courses at FTCC as you prepare to compete, but you will be enrolled in the Associate of General Education-Health Program during this time.

Phases

- There are two phases to the health application process.
 - Phase I General FTCC Admissions
 Process applies to all students.
 - Phase II Health Application Process applies only to health applicants

Phase I – Apply to FTCC

- General Admission Application <u>https://www.faytechcc.edu/apply-now/ftcc-admissions/#steps</u>
- Apply for Financial Aid
- Turn in Official Transcripts (High School and College)
- College Placement Entry Assessment
- Student Education Plan from Health Advising and Success Center
- Advisor Assignment
 - Access all Student Accounts (email, Blackboard, Self-Service)

Phase I (Continued)

- Visit the Health Advising and Success Center (Health Technology Center Room 142) or make an appointment with your program advisor for:
- Information about the program
 - Educational planning
 - Registration assistance
- Meet with your advisor at least once per semester.



Phase II – Secondary Health Program Application

- Submit Student Health Program Application
 - Access Online: FTCC Healthcare Programs Web Page (from FTCC Main Web Page search "healthcare programs" or "how to apply to a health program")
 - Application open **November 1 January 30 for August Entry** (for ALL programs)
 - 2nd application opens June 1 July 31 for January Entry (ONLY for Associate Degree Nursing and Pharmacy Technology programs)
 - After submitting the simple secondary Health Program Application, you will receive a confirmation note on screen.

Phase II – Secondary Health Program Application (Continued)

Notifications on Status sent via FTCC Student Email

- Health Applicant Rating Form (HARF) showing Eligibility and Initial Competitive Points and Health GPA – do not expect before late February
- Individual Programs Invite All "Eligible" applicants to Information Sessions – to earn "Extra" competitive points. Look on your program webpage to see the Competitive Point Worksheet.
- Selection Status emails sent as "Conditional Selected", "Alternate", or "Not Selected".

Prerequisites to Apply

- Pre-requisites shown on Healthcare Programs webpage or Section A of Student Education Plan. Different for each program.
- Must be completed prior to January 30 (all programs) or July 31 (A.D.N. only) to be considered a Category I applicant.
- Applicants can apply as Category II applicant, if they are registered at the time of application to take their FINAL pre-requisite course. Category II applicants considered after all Category I applicants offered seat.
- May be obtained through testing, courses, and/or certificates.
- Can be taken at FTCC if they were not successfully completed in high school.
- Prerequisite courses may only be attempted twice.
- Prerequisite courses do not expire, but entrance assessment test scores expire after 5 years.

Schedule your reservation – pay fee to schedule test

TEAS score is valid for 3 years

If you take the test at a location other than the FTCC Testing Office, (i.e., PSI Center, Online Proctor) you are responsible for having atitesting.com share your scores with FTCC

The test must be completed and score in your FTCC academic record by January 30 (all programs) or July 31 (A.D.N. only)

If scores are not in your record by January 30 (all programs) or July 31 (A.D.N. only) it may result in ineligibility

Cumulative GPA Versus Health GPA

Cumulative GPA

- Grade Point Average based on *all* coursework attempted and completed at FTCC
- Includes courses not required for health program

Health GPA (on Health Applicant Rating Form)

- Grade Point Average based only on the designated related courses used for computing competitive points on HARF (not the Elective or ACA).
- Includes related course grades that have not expired or been forgiven

Minimum GPA Requirements

- All programs require a minimum **Cumulative** GPA of 2.0.
- Degree programs require a minimum Health GPA of 2.5.
 - Diploma and certificate programs require a minimum Health GPA of 2.0.
- Cumulative and Health GPA requirements must be maintained throughout the selection process, including spring and summer semesters.



Category I Versus Category II Applicant

- Category I
 - Meets all prerequisite requirements
 - Meets January 30 or July 31 application deadline
 - Ranked before all Category II applicants
 - Category II
 - Currently enrolled in last prerequisite course
 - Does not include TEAS deadline
 - Misses January 30 or July 31 application deadline
 - Ranked after all Category I applicants

Competitive Points



- Competitive points can only be earned by:
 - Grades in Related Courses (Initial points)
 - Information Session program "additional" points
- High grades can earn you higher competitive points, increasing chances for selection
- Low grades can lower the Health GPA and place applicants in INELIGIBLE status

Calculation of Initial Competitive Points

- Related courses (except ACA and Humanities/ Fine Arts elective) are used for determining competitive points.
- For ALLIED HEALTH programs: Each course is worth a set number of semester hours of credit (SHC). Each letter grade has a numeric value and is multiplied by the SHC. An A in a 3 SHC course can earn 12 points.
- For NURSING programs: A set # of points will be earned based on the grade. ENG/PSY courses earn 4 points for A's, 3 points for B's and 2 points for C's. For BIO168 & BIO 169: A's earn 10 points, B's earn 5 points.
- "C" grades in related science courses earn "0" competitive points.

Related Course Notes

- Completed courses earn you competitive points
- Shown in Section B (2nd section) on Student Education Plan
- Courses required for degree that are not program specific
- Science courses may only be attempted twice
- Related science courses are valid for 5 years
- The following programs require a "B" or higher in related science courses (i.e., Anatomy & Physiology, Physics, Microbiology): Nursing, Dental Hygiene, Pharmacy, Physical Therapist Asst., Radiography, Speech Language Pathology Asst, & Surgical Tech.
 - These programs will allow a "C" or higher in related Science courses: Dental Assisting, EMS, Medical Lab Tech, & Respiratory Therapy.
 - Different for each health program Current requirements can be found on the FTCC website

If a program requires CIS 113 (1 SHC) and you take CIS 110 (3 SHC), points will be given based on the semester hour credits for CIS 113.

If a program requires BIO 175 (3 SHC) and you take BIO 275 (4 SHC), points will be given based on semester hour credits for BIO 175.

Health Applicant Rating Form (HARF)

- Applicants will receive a HARF via FTCC student email within 4-6 weeks after the closing of the application window.
- The form includes:
 - Eligibility
 - Initial Points Earned from Grades (does not include any of the "additional" program points)
 - Category Status
 - Health GPA calculated on the HARF based on grades earned in the designated related courses.

- Information used by the auditors completing the form
- The classes/ grades used to calculate competitive points
- Your Competitive Points
- Your Health GPA
- The decision on your status

HARF Appeals

- If you disagree with the information on the HARF, you have 10 days from the date the HARF was sent to appeal – not 10 days from the date you read the email.
- Complete the appeal form (H5) on the <u>FTCC</u> <u>website.</u>
- You will be notified via FTCC student email of the decision.

Information Sessions

- Sessions are program specific some programs do not hold Information Sessions and may request information from you via email.
 - You are notified of the date(s) and time(s) via FTCC student email if the program conducts a session.
 - Attendance is *required*.
 - You may earn "additional" program competitive points during the session.
 - "Additional points" are awarded at the discretion of the program. Information on additional points can be found on each program's website.

Final Calculation of Competitive Points

- After the Information Session, the program will determine the number of additional points earned by each student.
- The Information Session points will be added to the student's competitive points.
 - Applicants who do not attend the Information Session (invited to after receipt of HARF) will be removed from the competitive process.

Selection

- Category I applicants are placed on the list ahead of Category II applicants.
- Applicants are listed from highest points to lowest points in each category.
 - All programs have a limited number of seats.
 - Candidates from the highest points to the number of available seats are designated as *conditionally selected* (must accept or decline seat).
 - Candidates with the next highest points after those selected are placed on the alternate list. Alternates are selected if a seat becomes available.

Status Notification

- All applicants are notified via FTCC student email.
- Applicants are designated as:
 - Conditionally Selected
 - Alternate
 - Not Selected
- Notifications are usually sent in April and May.

Selected Candidate Online Response Form

Selected candidates have 7 days from the date the acceptance email was sent to submit the Online Response Form.

- Indicate "Accept" or "Decline".
- A program approval email will be sent via FTCC student email.

Keeping Your Seat

If candidates continue to take courses before entering the program, the minimum cumulative and major GPA requirements must be maintained.

Candidates must meet all departmental requirements such as submitting a completed health form, attending orientation, etc.

Failure to meet any departmental requirements will result in removal from the health program.

Admission Process Reopens

If a program does not fill to capacity, the admission process for that specific program may be reopened. Watch the FTCC website for notification of reopened programs.
