- High School juniors and seniors ONLY
- Unweighted GPA of 2.8 on High School Courses
 - OR Testing pre-requisites (i.e. PSAT, SAT, PACT, ACT, etc)
 - □ OR a waiver letter from the high school (for CTE's without UGETC courses only)
- Schedule: Most classes will run 1:00-3:00 Monday Friday and will follow the Cumberland County Schools schedule for holidays
- Transportation: Cumberland County Schools will offer transportation to FTCC from most of their comprehensive high schools. See your counselor for details.
- Cost: Tuition is waived. Students pay textbook/supply cost (uniforms and special equipment)
- **Graduation:** CTE certificate completers will graduate from FTCC in May of each year.
