
COLLEGE CREDIT FOR Military Training

JCSE (Joint Communications Support Elements)

Through the partnership with the Joint Communications Support Element (JCSE) all graduates of the Joint Operations Communication School earn 34 credit hours towards an Associates in General Education from FTCC. Additional credits will be awarded based on additional military training. Most qualified JCSE Service members earn a maximum transfer credit of 48 credit hours.

The following classes must be completed to be awarded the Associates in General Education:

ENG 111 Writing Inquiry - 3 credit hrs.

ENG 112 Writing/Research in the Disc - 3 credit hrs.

MAT 143 Quantitative Literacy or higher level Math -

3 credit hrs.

COM 120 Interpersonal Communication - 3 credit hrs.

ACA 122 College Transfer Success

Elective 3 credit hrs.

Transfer credit for these courses will be accepted upon approval from FTCC. Sixteen (16) credit hours or 25% of the degree must be completed through FTCC on site or online in order to meet our Residency Requirement. Students who receive transfer credit for any of the above courses may replace those credits with approved Electives.

SELF-PACED Online Flex Courses

FTCC's online flex courses offer military students an opportunity to earn the remaining credits they need to complete the Associate in General Education (AGE) degree in a flexible, self-paced format:
