Navigating the Road to Recovery – Update

- The deadline for North Carolinians who are eligible to participate in North Carolina's Sheltering and Temporary Essential Power (STEP) program has been extended to **Feb. 1**.
- The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) announced that its Disaster Loan Outreach Centers located in Jacksonville and New Bern North Carolina will cease operations at 5 p.m. on **Monday, Feb. 4.** That will also be SBA representatives' last day at the state Housing Recovery Center in Wilmington.

Unmet Needs

FEMA works closely with state, federal, faith-based and voluntary agency partners. Survivors who do not qualify for FEMA disaster assistance may call **2-1-1**, the statewide information and referral service for basic unmet needs—such as food or cleaning supplies and help to pay utility bills and child-care expenses.

Disaster Tax Relief

Survivors of Hurricane Florence may qualify for tax relief from the Internal Revenue Service. Taxpayers may be eligible for deadline extensions to file returns or pay taxes, and may be able to claim qualified disaster losses. The IRS may waive fees and expedite requests from survivors.
