

# ATI TEST OF ESSENTIAL ACADEMIC SKILLS (ATI TEAS)

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Prior to registering for the ATI TEAS, applicants must have a current FTCC admissions and residency application on file or currently enrolled in FTCC curriculum courses. The ATI TEAS Exam at FTCC is ONLY offered to prospective FTCC Associate Degree Nursing, FTCC Dental Hygiene and FTCC Practical Nursing Students. All ATI TEAS exam registrations are FINAL and WILL **NOT** be refunded.
- Prospective Associate Degree Nursing, Dental Hygiene, Medical Sonography, and FTCC Practical Nursing Students competing for the Health Admissions Competitive process are required to take the ATI TEAS Exam.
- It is highly recommended to take the ATI TEAS after completion of transition, developmental, and prerequisite courses.
  - **Associate Degree Nursing**: Take the ATI TEAS after completion of college-level English and BIO-168.
  - **Dental Hygiene**: Take the ATI TEAS after completion of college-level English and BIO-163.
  - **Medical Sonography**: Take the ATI TEAS after completion of college-level English and BIO-163.
  - **Practical Nursing**: Take the ATI TEAS after completion of college-level English and BIO-163.

## TESTING DAY

- Arrive 30 minutes early to the test site in which you paid registration, Center for Business and Industry, Room 135 or Spring Lake Center, Room 101
- Late arrivals will **NOT** be allowed to test.
- Allow 4 hours to take the test.
- Bring an unexpired government-issued photo ID and your **ATI username and password**.
- Calculators, cell phones and other electronic devices are **NOT** allowed.
- Food and drink are **NOT** allowed. Scratch paper and pencil will be provided.

## What is the ATI TEAS?

The **ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills** (ATI TEAS) was developed to measure basic essential skills in the academic content area domains of reading, mathematics, science and

English and language usage. These entry-level skills were deemed important for health science program applicants by a panel of program curriculum experts. The TEAS is a 170-item multiple choice assessment.

## What is on the ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS is a timed computerized exam made up of 170-item multiple-choice questions. The ATI TEAS is composed of four sections: Reading, Math, Science and English and Language Usage.

<b>Reading</b> -section includes paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension, and inferences/conclusions.	<b>45</b>	<b>55 minutes</b>
<b>Mathematics</b> -section includes whole numbers, metric conversion, fractions, decimals, algebraic equations, percentages, and ratio/proportion.	<b>38</b>	<b>57 minutes</b>
<b>Science</b> -section includes science reasoning, science knowledge, biology, chemistry, anatomy, physiology, basic physical principles, and general science.	<b>50</b>	<b>60 minutes</b>
<b>English and Language Usage</b> section includes punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, contextual words, and spelling.	<b>37</b>	<b>37 minutes</b>
<b>Total</b>	<b>170</b>	<b>209 minutes</b>
