Dear Student,

Thank you for your interest in Cumberland County's Finish Line Grant Program, a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) initiative!

Too often, unexpected financial emergencies arise such as automobile repairs, child care and emergency needs involving medical, housing, utility bills, school tuition and books which inhibit community college students from reaching their educational milestone.

The Finish Line grant is designed to assist you in completing your course studies when facing unforeseen challenges! To determine eligibility, students must:

- Be in good academic standing
- Be enrolled in an approved curriculum/course
- Have completed at least 50% of their degree/credential
- Complete a finish Line Grant Application Form
- Provide supporting documentation of the financial need (*i.e. automotive repair estimate, documented notice of unexpected change in housing or utilities expense, etc.*).
- Provide documentation that student is unable to get assistance from another source to address the need
- Provide proof of selective service registration (*for males age 18 and older only*)
- Complete application for enrollment into a WIOA Title I Program
  - Valid Identification: Driver's License/State ID/School ID/Military ID
  - Citizenship Verification: Birth Certificate, US Passport, Certificate or Naturalization
  - Social Security Card- original and signed
  - Address Verification: School Record/ Utility Bill / Lease / Mortgage / State ID / Government Document
  - Income Verification: Paystubs (6 months), SNAP, SSI, or SSDI letter

The above listed documentation is **required** to determine your enrollment eligibility in the WIOA Program and for financial assistance under the Finish Line Grant.

We look forward to assisting you in eliminating roadblocks so that you can continue reaching your education goals!
