**THE AGGIE PLUS PROGRAM  
BETWEEN  
NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY  
AND  
FAYETTEVILLE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into by and between **NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY**, a public university located in Greensboro, North Carolina (hereinafter "N.C. A&T") and **FAYETTEVILLE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE**, a North Carolina Community College System Institution (hereinafter "FTCC"). **THE AGGIE PLUS PROGRAM** is a co-admissions program designed to provide prospective FTCC transfer students a seamless transition to N.C. A&T.

This Agreement shall be reviewed at least once every three years, by the designated officials at both institutions and is subject to change by mutual written consent. Either party may revoke this agreement by written notice to the other party, giving at least one year's notice of intent to discontinue the Agreement. However, it is understood and agreed that any student admitted to N.C. A&T under this Agreement will be allowed to complete the program notwithstanding the termination provision above, so long as such student is in good standing and is making progress toward degree completion. This Agreement is effective beginning the Fall 2020.

**1. Program Requirements**

- All Aggie Plus participants must earn an Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), or Associate in Engineering (AE) degree.
- All Aggie Plus participants must select transferable courses using the N.C. A&T Pathways and consult with FTCC advisors to ensure that they are making progress toward their specific major choice or general education requirements at N.C. A&T.
- All Aggie Plus participants must maintain a 2.0 cumulative FTCC GPA and obtain a "C" or better on all transferable coursework. Some N.C. A&T Academic Programs may have additional admissions requirements.
- Following the completion of the AA, AS, or AE degree, all Aggie Plus participants will transfer to N.C. A&T to complete their undergraduate degree.

**2. Application Process**

All prospective Aggie Plus participants will need to complete the following steps prior to the start of their first semester at FTCC.

- Submit the *Aggie Plus Program Online Commitment Form*
- Submit official proof of admission to FTCC

**3. Program Benefits**

- Targeted advising from an Aggie Plus advisor at FTCC and N.C. A&T
- Aggie Plus participants will receive priority review in the N.C. A&T admissions process
- The application fee will be waived for all Aggie Plus participants
- 1 Aggie Plus program orientation session at FTCC at the beginning of each fall term
- 1 Aggie Plus program visit day at N.C. A&T during the spring term
