It involves the careful process of passing wire through a series of holes (or dies) in a machine to make it thinner.

What we expect of you:

- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs.
- Attention to detail and ability to check your own work for accuracy.

You will be responsible for setting up the machine, stringing the wire onto the machine, operating it, inspecting the wire, and clean-up. You will adjust parts on the machine and operate tools.

While there's certainly plenty of physical work that comes with drawing wire, the mental aspect of the job is just as important.
