Job Description:

Looking for a part-time, temporary position allowing you to be outside enjoying amazing lake scenery? Then OWASA may have what you are looking for.

Seeking to fill a Part-time, Temporary Lake Assistant position. This person would assist with weekend operations of University Lake and Cane Creek Reservoir during recreational season. Assignment is from late March through early November, working weekends, up to 29 hours per week.

Key responsibilities include:

- Operating mowers and other landscaping equipment.
- Renting recreation equipment to lake patrons and helping to enforce lake rules and safety.
- Evaluating private boats and motors.
- Housekeeping of building and other areas as needed.

Job Description:

Orange Water and Sewer Authority (OWASA) is seeking individuals interested in acquiring training, skills, and certifications as a Water or Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator. This opportunity prepares individuals for a rewarding career in the water or wastewater industry. This one-year program consists of on-the-job training, mentorship, and classroom instruction resulting in preparation for professional certifications in the water or wastewater field.

While in the program, apprentices commit to a 40-hour weekly schedule and are considered a temporary employee. The expectation is once the program is complete, the apprentice will be eligible to become certified as an operator in either a water or wastewater system and have knowledge, skills, and abilities to thrive as an industry professional. Completion of the Apprenticeship program does not guarantee a full-time position with OWASA.

Pay and Benefits:

- Salary is \$20.43 per hour
- Participation in the North Carolina Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System
- Employer paid medical premiums for Apprentice; 50% paid toward dependent coverage
- 12 paid Holidays
- Monthly vacation and sick leave
