- COURSE START DATES: Corporate & Continuing Education classes begin in different weeks and months. Check start dates to be sure you

This course provides prospective auto dealers with the 12 hours of authorized pre-licensing training required by the Department of Motor Vehicles to be licensed as a North Carolina independent auto dealer. AUTO DEALER'S RENEWAL TRAINING - ONLINE

All auto dealers (under the age of 65) are required to attend this training in order to renew their license. The law requires that the person whose name is on your auto dealer's license must attend this training, although it would be helpful for anyone working in independent auto sales to attend. Failure to attend and complete this six-hour requirement will result in a revocation of your dealer license. The intent of this training is to provide annual updates to all independent dealers on contemporary issues. At the conclusion of this class, you will receive a certificate of completion. Supplies: Students must have access to a computer or tablet with a microphone and camera. NOTE: Course workbook is included in the registration fee. Training will include the use of state-of-the-art equipment used by the automotive collision industry in repair of damaged and rusted body parts as well as historical methods of repair used to restore older vehicles.
