## GENERAL INFORMATION

- **COURSE START DATES:** Corporate & Continuing Education classes begin in different weeks and months. Check start dates to be sure you won't miss a course.

- **PARKING:** Students enrolled in Corporate & Continuing Education classes will need a temporary parking decal to park on the **Fayetteville campus**. These temporary passes are free to current students, and are available from the Registration and Records Office in the Tony Rand Student Center. The pass should be placed on the dashboard of the vehicle. Designated parking for students are the spaces with white lines. If you register online, please request a pass from the Registration and Records Office.
- **POLICY ON THE NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL SECURITY REPORT AVAILABILITY:** Fayetteville Technical Community College's annual security report is available on the FTCC website. This report is required by federal law and contains policy statements and crime statistics for the College. ### ANGER MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST - NEW! SARA

This training course is a comprehensive professional training designed to equip facilitators, educators, counselors, and helping professionals with the practical skills and strategies needed to deliver effective anger management interventions. This course is grounded in the N.O. C.A.P. framework-Nurture, Orient, Connect, Activate, and Power-a trauma-informed, holistic model that supports long-term emotional growth rather than short-term behavior control. Participants will learn evidence-based techniques for identifying emotional triggers, teaching self-regulation skills, and guiding individuals through healthy conflict resolution. The course also provides clear instruction on group facilitation methods, assessment tools, and documentation practices. By the end of the training, participants will be equipped to confidently lead anger management sessions in settings such as private practice, schools, community programs, and court-mandated environments. Successful completion of the class and the final exam results in certification.

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### BEHAVIOR TECHNICIAN - HYBRID SARA

Through the Behavior Technician program, you will receive the training needed to become a paraprofessional in the field of Autism services. This course provides an understanding of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and best practices for assisting children and adults with functional communication acquisition, social skill development, and behavior change. You will learn about Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), an empirically validated method for changing behaviors and teaching social and adaptive living skills. This 65-hour course includes 25 hours of live instruction and 40 hours' worth of online modules that you complete at your own pace. If you complete this course successfully, you will receive a Behavior Technician (BT) certificate and will be eligible for entry-level positions in the field. After the course, you may choose to complete additional assessments to become certified as a Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board. Prevalence of Autism Spectrum Disorder and changes in insurance mandates drive high demand for ABA services and RBT recruitment.





To meet national and state demands for employment within the renewable energy sector, Fayetteville Technical Community College (FTCC) has formed a partnership with **Cumberland County Schools (CCS)**, Cape Fear High School, Douglas Byrd High School, E.E. Smith High School, Grays Creek High School, Jack Britt High School, Westover High School and 71<sup>st</sup> High School and two major energy industry employers (**Blue Ridge Power** and **Public Works Commission**) to implement a new pathway that will help grow the future workforce within this sector.


