

Certified Medication Aide

Students must attend the **1st day of class**. Failure to attend class by the 2nd day of class will result in the student being dropped from the program. Any/all documents not received by **the 1st day of class will result in counseling**. If the **Picture ID and *High School Diplomas** are not received by the **3rd day**, the student will be dropped from the course.

- Tuition Fee: \$125
- Uniform: Uniforms are not required for this program, however, **students should adhere to the FTCC dress code policy or may wear scrubs of their choice.**

 - **MUST BE CNA I Certified and be active on the Nurse Aide Registry – WILL BE VERIFIED BY FTCC HEALTH PROGRAMS STAFF/FACULTY UPON REGISTRATION**

Non-compliance with ANY deadline listed above can result in dismissal from the program.

This course prepares students to administer medications in a long-term care or skilled nursing facility under the supervision of an RN. Students taking this course *will not* be eligible to administer medication in adult care homes, assisted living facilities, or a family care home.

Students will learn the concepts of medication administration, scope of practice for the Medication Aide, the six rights of medication administration for non-licensed personnel and demonstrate the proper and safe techniques for medication administration for oral, eye, ear, nasal, transdermal, topical, inhalant, vaginal, and rectal administration routes.

Upon successful completion of this program, the student can sit for the NC Medication Aide State Exam at an additional fee.
