This Thursday, May 2nd, is #WorldPasswordDay. It's a good time to strengthen and change your passwords. Some tips include:

- Use a password manager
 - Since you should have long passwords or passphrases that are unique to all accounts you have, then you will have a hard time remembering them all. So you need a safe way to store them.
- Change passwords annually that are not supported by multi-factor authentication.
- Implement multi-factor authentication on all sites that support it.
- Avoid playing those social media quizzes that ask you for personal details. You may not realize it, but many of the questions are ones that are used by sites to help you reset your passwords.
- This may be about Password Day, but I
 would be remise if I did not mention that you
 should also educate yourselves on using
 passkeys instead of passwords, to improve
 security.

Scholarships for students are available for both Summer and Fall!

Get up to **\$500** for full-time students for the Summer semester. (Full-time is 6 credit hours). Applications for 2024SU are **due May 20th**.

Get up to **\$1000** for full-time students for the Fall semester. (Full-time is 12 credit hours). Applications for 2024FA are due **August 12th**.

These funds do not get 'banked', so if you already have funding from a previous CCN grant, you cannot apply again.

FAQ

1. I've already applied in the past but used all my funding. Can I apply again?

Yes, you can reapply so long as you adhered to all other requirements stated in the application and do not have any existing CCN funding available.

2. I have financial aid and/or VA benefits, can I apply?

Yes, you can apply and qualify for funding. However, funding will not be deposited to your student account to use towards tuition/books. If you have other means of funding, you are only eligible to use CCN funding towards certification exam vouchers.

3. What if I withdraw from a class?

If you withdraw from a class, you may be denied CCN funding in a future semester and will be required to repay the funds used.

4. How do I apply?

To apply for **summer**, please complete <u>THIS FORM</u>. To apply for **fall**, please complete <u>THIS FORM</u>.

5. Do I get disbursements like financial aid?

No, if you receive CCN funding, it remains in your student account until it is exhausted; these funds are not disbursed in the same way financial aid is.
