

About the Fayetteville Rose Garden

Established in 1972, the Fayetteville Rose Garden features approximately 700 roses consisting of 25 different varieties ranging from miniature roses, to grandifloras, to modern shrub roses, and classic hybrid teas. Over 100 of the roses in the garden today were part of the original rose garden which was designed by Augusta Knight, a member of the Fayetteville Rose Society.

The garden was truly a community project. The City of Fayetteville, Fayetteville Beautiful, the Garden Club Council, the Fayetteville Rose Society and FTCC, then known as Fayetteville Technical Institute, were all instrumental in making the garden a reality. The partnership between FTCC and the FRS has continued through the years. The FRS provides new roses and rose growing expertise. FTCC provides the daily maintenance and care of the garden.
