

## Global Experience: International Business

To qualify, students must complete steps 1-4, provide physical evidence for steps 1-4, and a log of hours spent (maximum **10** of the 30 hours required in total):

Steps	Actions	Details	Evidence
1	Identify an internship at an international business in Fayetteville or surrounding areas.	Research international businesses that offer internships.  Set up an internship	List of websites/contact information for local international businesses.  Email correspondence used to set up internship  Log of hours spent planning.
2	Intern at an international business in a surrounding county for at least 10 hours.	Work an internship with an international business.  Interview a staff member of the organization on the importance of intercultural cooperation.	Journal of Internship experiences.  Video of interview.  Log of hours spent at internship.
3	Reflect on experience by answering the assigned questions.	See Key Reflection Questions and Capstone Guidelines	A document submitted to Global Scholars Committee answering the reflection questions (also embedded in the capstone presentation)
4	Present Capstone	Design a product (for example: PowerPoint, video, Prezi, website, blog, ePortfolio, etc.) which includes summary of experience and critical reflection using Step 3 on this and/or other experiences	A presentation which critically reflects on the global experience. Approximately 15 minutes.

### Key Reflection Questions

1. How did your perception of international business change as a result of the internship?
2. How did your perception of the importance of intercultural cooperation change as a result of the internship.

3. How do you see your experience influencing your future life – academically, professionally, personally?

4. Discuss a challenge you faced from the internship and how you dealt with it. What did you learn as a result of facing this challenge?
