Nursing Extra Competitive Points Instructions November 1, 2025-January 30, 2026 Application Cycle 2026 Fall Entry

Attention: All documents for extra competitive points must be submitted at time of application.

1. Direct client care work experience in the health field

Follow these guidelines for submission:

Have your employer complete a **current** *FTCC Work Experience* form (**see template on page 2**). Yes, it must be updated for every Application Cycle.

- The employer's signature and date must be **handwritten**
- To receive points the applicant must reflect direct client care experience for at least 1040 hours on the form
- Verification of work experience must be updated and resubmitted for each new application cycle.
- For military personnel in healthcare roles (MOS 68 series or equivalent), a DD-214 may be submitted as proof of direct client care employment
- All submissions must adhere to the required file naming conventions and format. Files submitted incorrectly risk being lost, uncounted, or deemed **ineligible** during an appeal.

 - **Allowed file types:** Word, PDF, JPEG

- Unofficial transcripts showing the completion or award date of the certificate/degree.
- Photo of the actual diploma or degree with the College/University Seal.
- Please **Only** submit one transcript or photo of the highest level you have earned.
- All submissions must adhere to the required file naming conventions and format. Files submitted incorrectly risk being lost, uncounted, or deemed **ineligible** during an appeal.

Nursing Admission Essay June-November 2025-January 2026 Application Cycle

The Nursing Program offers candidates seeking admission the opportunity to submit an admission essay along with their competitive point materials. The guidelines below must be followed when developing the essay.

This essay allows you to reflect on your personal journey, values, and vision for your future in nursing.

Introduction

Begin by reflecting on your journey toward nursing. Describe experiences or influences that shaped your interest in the field and what nursing means to you. Consider how your academic and personal growth have prepared you to take this next step.

Body

Explain how your educational background, work, or volunteer experiences have helped you develop skills essential to nursing — such as clinical reasoning, communication, and ethical decision-making. Use specific examples that show how you've grown through learning, teamwork, and perseverance.

Conclusion

Connect your past experiences to your future goals. Describe the kind of nurse you aspire to become and how your preparation will help you succeed in the program and in professional practice. End with a statement that reflects your motivation and readiness to serve others through nursing.

Essay Format:

- Essay should be written in MLA format, with Times New Roman and 12pt font
- Essay must include a well-defined introduction, body, and conclusion
- Essays under 500 words or over 750 words, excluding student information and title line, will not be accepted. Refer to the yellow highlight on the next page for an example of what will not be counted.
- Be sure to read the Nursing Essay Topic Sample, next page, for more formatting specifics.

The rubric below will be used to score the essay. Candidates should carefully review their essay prior to submission to ensure quality.

Be sure to review the essay topic on the *Nursing Essay Criteria 2026FA* document. This is a basic sample of how your document should look when you compose your response to this topic. Please read the guidelines thoroughly to ensure your essay is received and eligible to move forward for evaluation. The essay should be written in a Word Document using Times New Roman font at a 12-point font size. The margins for your essay should be one inch all the way around the page. Your response should be at least 500 words, but not to exceed 750 words, double-spaced. The word count will not include the header or the title.

Please be sure to review the specific file-saving, and submission requirements. If there are issues, questions, or concerns regarding your essay, you will be notified by email. If you have any inquiries about the essay portion, please ask through the applynursing@faytechcc.edu email. **Essays must be submitted electronically at the time you submit your application to be considered for competitive points.**
