STEP ONE: Applying to FTCC:

 - Application Times:
 - FALL semester entry for LPN and ADN: (Applicants may apply for both programs)
 - November 1 January 30 for the following Fall semester
 - SPRING semester entry for ADN ONLY:
 - June 1 July 31 for the following Spring semester
