



# SHOPPING SHEET INFORMATION VETERANS/DEPENDENTS

Section 1018 of Public Law 116-315, Johnny Isakson and David P. Roe, M.D. Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020, requires educational institutions to make certain disclosures to students using federal military and/or VA education benefits. To ensure compliance with the law, we have developed the Shopping Sheet Information for Student Veterans/Veterans' Dependents.

- **Estimated cost of courses including tuition, fees, books, supplies, living expenses and other additional costs.**

The cost of tuition and fees are different if a student is a NC resident or an out of state student. For information on the estimated cost, please visit <https://www.faytechcc.edu/coa>

Please note that your final cost depends on your VA benefits. Do your VA education benefits cover tuition, fees, books and supplies? Housing allowance or stipend may help to cover your costs. Your cost will also depend on the number of courses you take. - **Amount of cost above what is covered by VA benefits.**

Your covered costs will depend upon your particular VA benefit.

- **Types of Federal financial aid offered by the institution that the student may be qualified to receive.**

Students using Veterans education benefits are encouraged to apply for financial aid online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) to be considered for federal, state, and institution grants/loans, as well as scholarships. FTCC's School Code is 007640.

- **Estimated amount of student loan debt upon completion of a degree or certificate/diploma.**

Students should borrow responsibly. This means only borrowing what you need. A dependent student with less than 31 credit hours completed may borrow \$5,500, if eligible. A dependent student with more than 30 credit hours completed may borrow \$6,500, if eligible. Independent students may borrow up to an additional \$4,000, if eligible.

- **Transfer credits including military credits**

Students receiving VA education benefits are required to submit all of their college transcripts/military credits to the Admissions Department no later than the end of their second semester. All students should meet with their advisor (or, alternatively, a success coach/counselor) to determine how those credits are applied to their educational goals.
