Nurse Aide II

Course Description

The Nursing Assistant II course prepares graduates to perform more complex skills for patients or residents regardless of the setting. The course includes class, laboratory, and clinical learning experiences. Upon satisfactory completion of the course and the skill/competency evaluation, the graduate is eligible to apply for listing as a Nurse Aide II with the North Carolina Board of Nursing Aide Registry. In all employment settings, the listed Nursing Assistant II will work under the direction and supervision of licensed personnel.

Students must provide proof of an active Nurse Aide I Certification to register for Nurse Aide II. Students must attend the 1st day of class. Failure to attend by the 2nd day of class will result in automatic withdrawal from the program
