Nurse Aide I

Course Description

This course prepares graduates to provide personal care and perform basic nursing skills for the elderly and other adults. During this program, emphasis will be placed on the process of aging including mental, social, and physical needs of the elderly, patient rights, nutrition management, diseases/disorders, and human body structure and function, etc. The course includes class (both face to face and virtual), laboratory, and clinical learning experiences. Students must be able to read and communicate in English effectively. Students must have good computer literacy skills to be successful in this program.

- Class: 48 hours
- Lab: 64 hours
- Clinical: 48 hours

Nurse Aide I (Hybrid): 160 hours (includes both face to face and virtual/class sessions.)

- Online: 40 hours
- Class: 10 hours
- Lab: 62 hours
- Clinical: 48 hours
