




At FTCC, Poleshka has been known for her willingness to help her fellow students understand their course assignments, especially when there is an English-Spanish language barrier. Her tendency to assist other people also carries over to her life outside of school. For instance, she is a devoted volunteer with the American Red Cross, the North Carolina Coastal Pines Girl Scouts, and Second Harvest Food Bank. Since she has two children of her own with special needs, she always seeks opportunities to make life more manageable for other families.

In the aftermath of Hurricane Maria, Poleshka immediately began trying to get in touch with relatives and friends in Puerto Rico, and she eventually found housing and transportation for several family members here in the United States. She also kept in touch with hurricane survivors still in Puerto Rico, to make sure that the basic necessities were reaching them.

As an outstanding example of a non-traditional student with responsibilities at home, in the community, and on campus, Poleshka graduated with honors from Fayetteville Tech in May. She received an Associate's Degree in Pharmacy Technology and was also presented with the President's Award, which is the highest honor that FTCC bestows.

Since graduation day, Poleshka has continued to hear from her former instructors that she would be an ideal candidate for a Bachelor's degree and a career as a pharmacist. The next two or three years would be quite a challenge for her, but of course Poleshka Delgado knows all about challenges!
