- Summerscapes **registration closes at 4:45 pm three business days before the class start date.** For example, for classes beginning on Mon. 6/1, registration will close at 4:45 pm on Wed. 5/27.

**LOCATIONS:** Classes are held at various locations to include the Continuing Education Center (CEC), Horace Sisk (HOS), Advanced Technology Center (ATC), Virtual College Center (VCC), and the Center for Business & Industry (CBI). 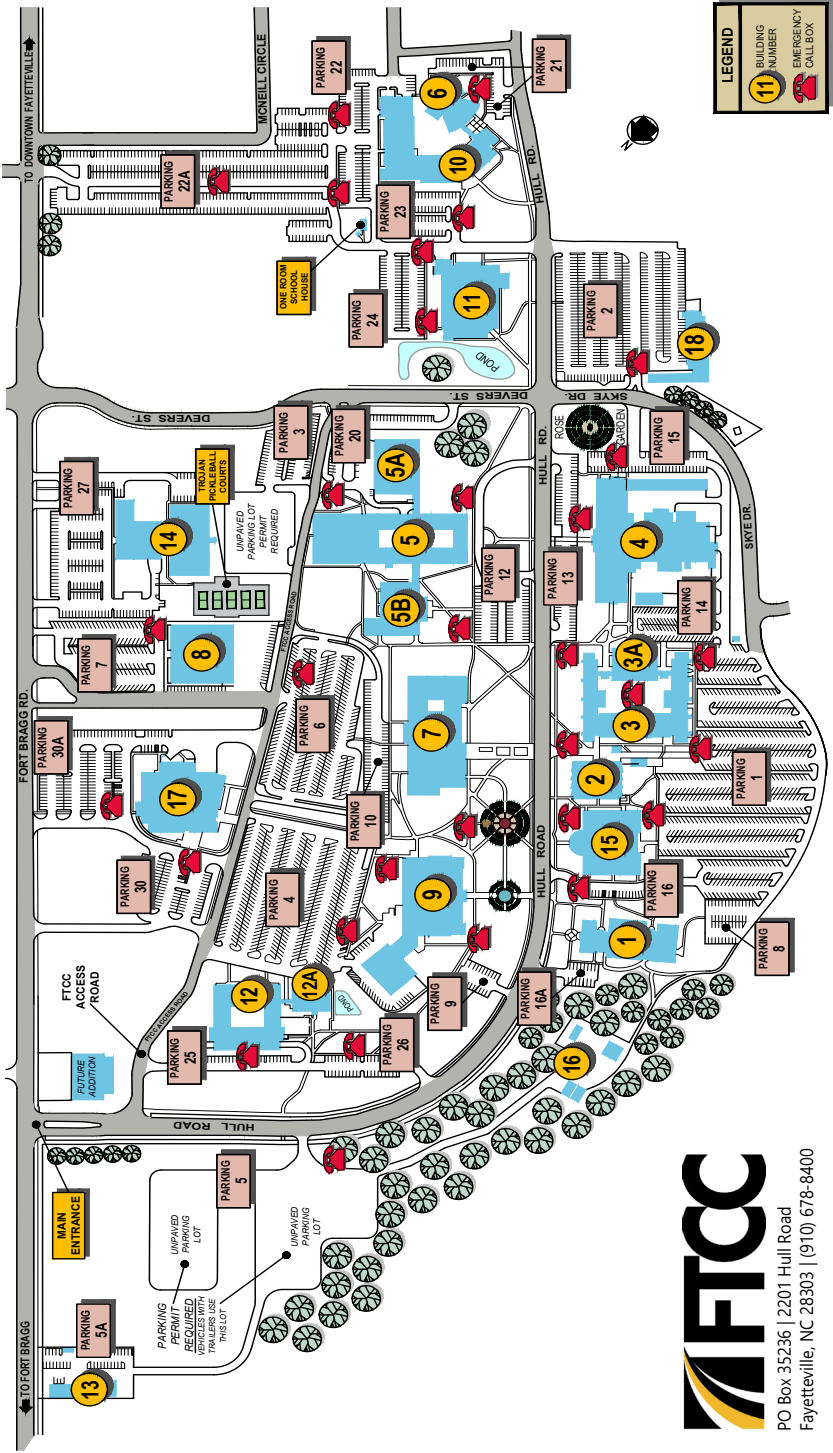
