

during the initial training and internship experiences. After completion of the internship, students will then be eligible for employment with businesses participating in the OJT program. Participants will receive technical instruction and on-the-job training, taking advantage of

an “earn-as-you-learn” model to get into the workforce through an accelerated path to employment.

HOPE programs include: wood-frame construction, plumbing, electrical, HVAC, property maintenance and automotive service technician.

A new adult-learner program at Fayetteville Technical Community College HOPE re-connect, or Hope, Opportunity and Prosperity through Education-seeks to provide accelerated training in high-demand skills to county residents without a college degree, including those with some college, a high school diploma or less. As part of the program, partnerships with employers to provide HOPE students with work-based learning internships and on-the-job training (OJT) experiences. Part of the funds will help provide cost-of-living stipends to participating students
